- promoting green technology from the Parkland Acquisitions and Renovations for Communities (PARC) program

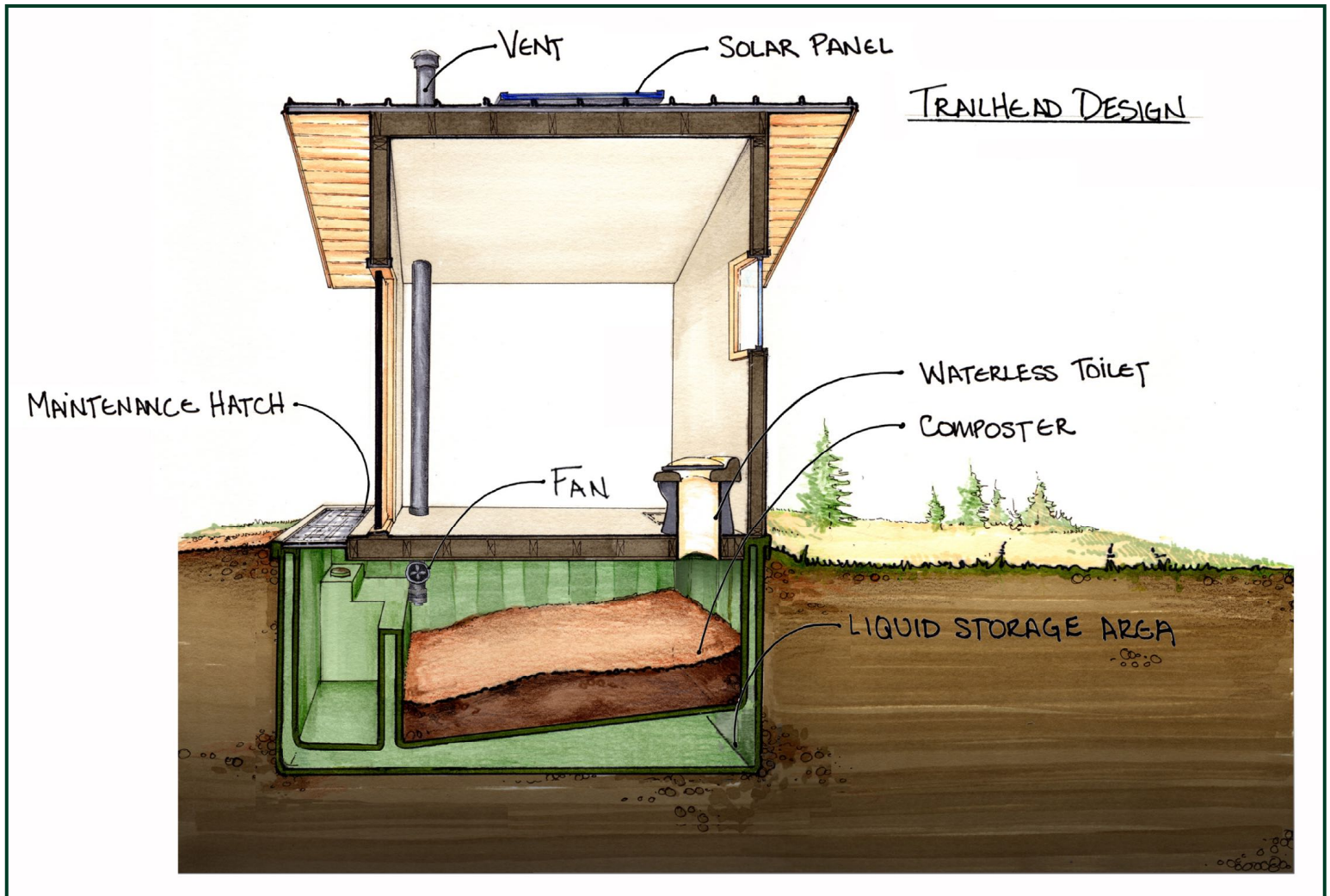
Challenge

- Provide safe, sanitary restrooms
- Portable, rented toilet buildings are unappealing and prone to 'tipping'
- Too costly to connect to sewer
- Septic system installation would damage fields and playground areas

Solution

- Installed Clivus self-contained composting restroom buildings
- Eliminated sewage and wastewater
- Saved money and preserved land in and around the parks





All Clivus systems are NSF Standard 41 Tested and Certified

The Clivus Model C11 trailhead restroom is a heavy duty building with a self-contained composting waste treatment system. There is no discharge of waste or pollution, site disturbance is limited to the footprint of the building, and the ventilation fan can be operated with solar power if necessary.

These units are all ADA accessible and can be placed in remote areas.
