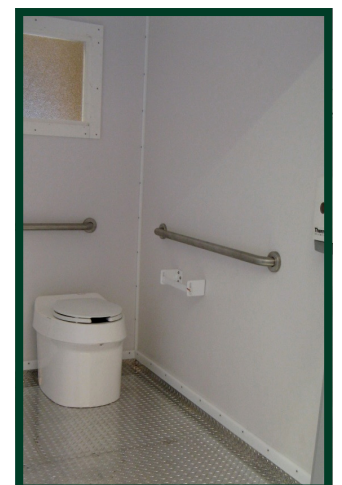
- Century old city park in need of restrooms

- Miniature golf course
- Remote areas with no sewer or water

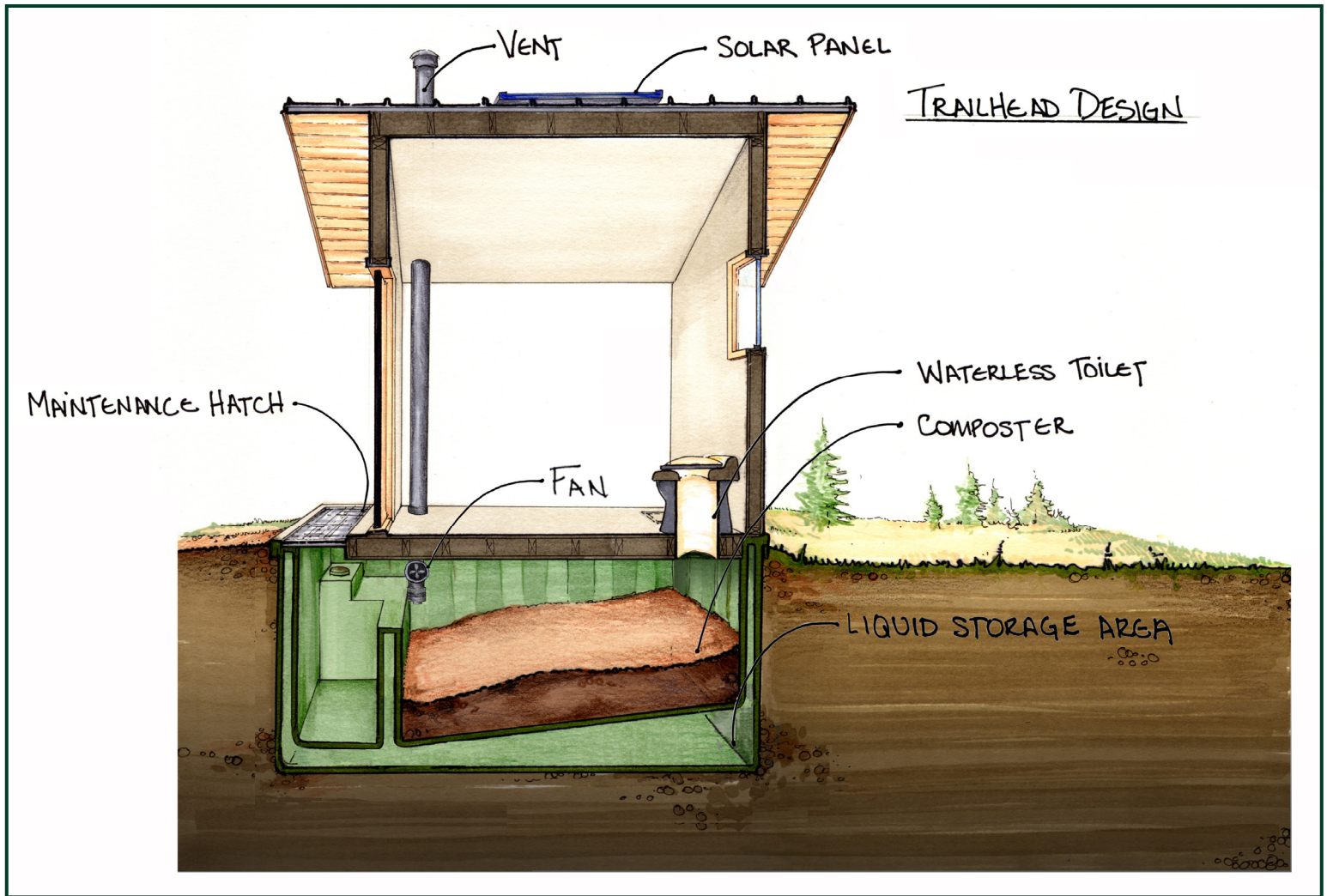
Challenge

- Encourage prolonged, healthy outdoor activity
- Increase park visitation
- Provide safe, sanitary restrooms
- Portable, rented toilets are unappealing and prone to 'tipping'
- Sewer is unavailable
- Minimize land used for waste disposal area

Solution

- Installed Clivus self-contained composting restroom buildings
- Eliminated sewage and wastewater
- Preserved land use
- Partially funded through HUD Community Development Block Grant 2013 & 2014
- Site improvement design by Carolyn Cooney & Associates, Milford, MA





All Clivus systems are NSF Standard 41 Tested and Certified

The Clivus Model C11 trailhead restroom is a heavy duty building with a self-contained composting waste treatment system. There is no discharge of waste or pollution, site disturbance is limited to the footprint of the building, and the ventilation fan can be operated with solar power if necessary.

These units are all ADA accessible and can be placed in remote areas.
