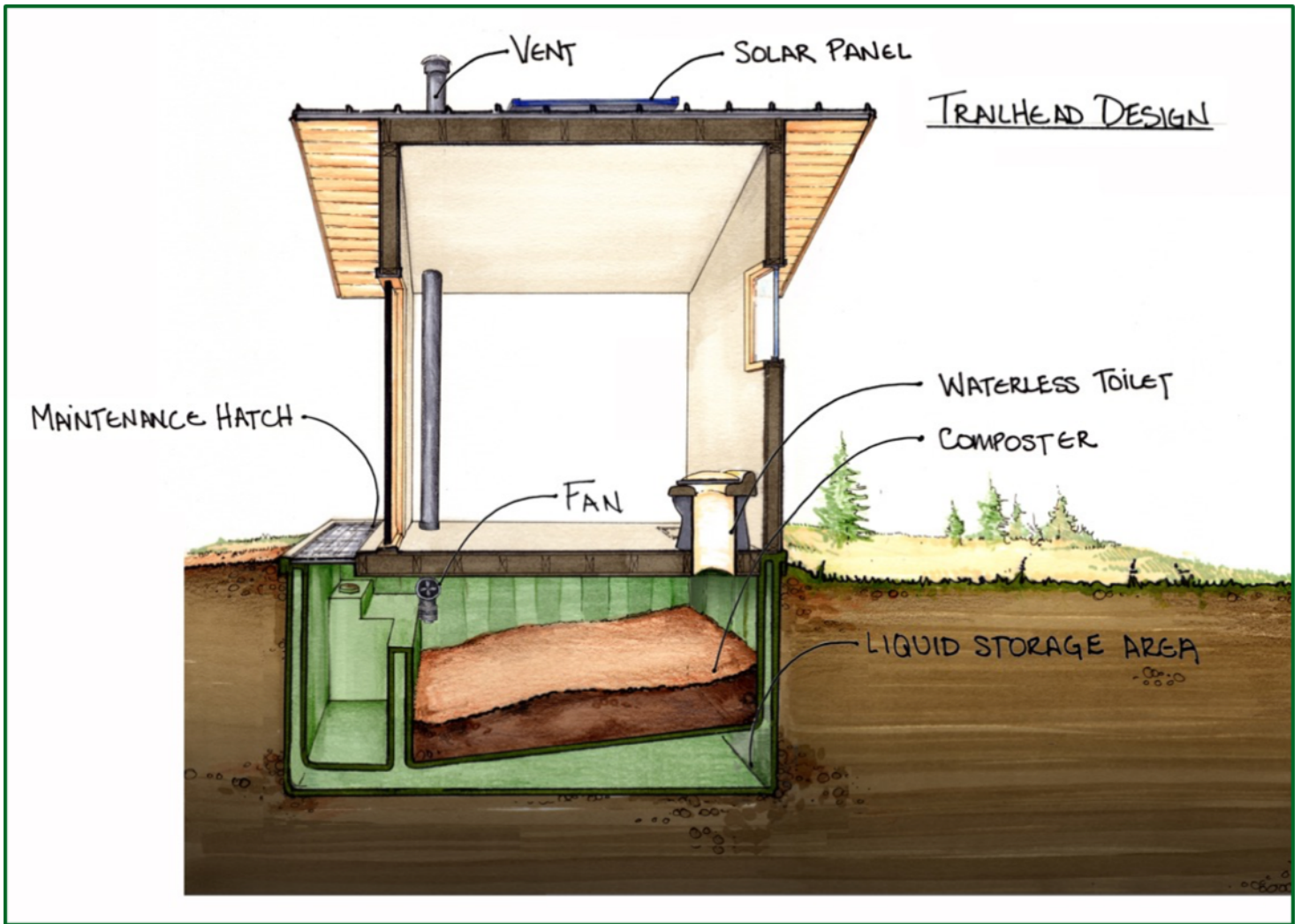
Challenge

- Furnish “comfort” amenities to expand tourism
- Provide clean and odor-free restroom
- No onsite power, sewer, or septic
- Minimize footprint of excavation for waste treatment system

Solution

- Installed Clivus self-contained, waterless composting system with solar powered ventilation
- Land dedicated for waste treatment is minimal
- Funded in part through a green space grant from RI DEM





All Clivus systems are NSF Standard 41 Tested

The Clivus Model C-11 trailhead restroom is a heavy duty building with a self-contained composting waste treatment system. There is no discharge of waste or pollution, site disturbance is limited to the footprint of the building, and the ventilation can be operated with solar power if necessary.

These units are all ADA accessible and can be placed in remote areas.
