- Need for centralized restroom

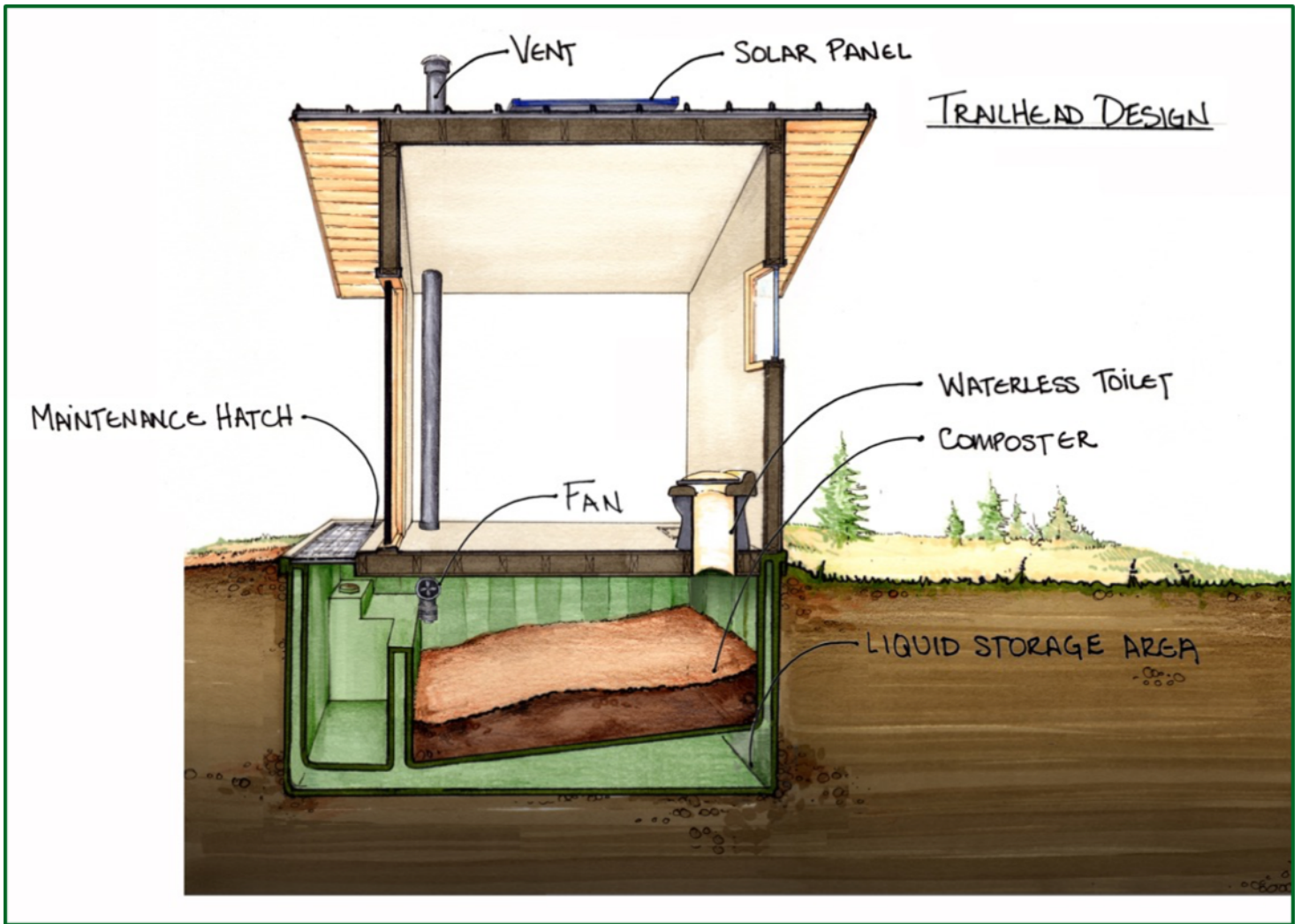
Challenge

- Provide waste treatment system to handle daily usage of overnight guests and day visitors
- Protect the environment from polluting waste discharge
- No sewer or septic on site
- Create minimal site disturbance to preserve the natural landscape

Solution

- Clivus self-contained, waterless composting system
- Eliminated all discharge of waste
- Minimized land usage for waste treatment
- Custom buildings designed by The Cushman Design Group, Stowe, VT





All Clivus systems are NSF Standard 41 Tested

The Clivus Model C-11 trailhead restroom is a heavy duty building with a self-contained composting waste treatment system. There is no discharge of waste or pollution, site disturbance is limited to the footprint of the building, and the ventilation can be operated with solar power if necessary.

These units are all ADA accessible and can be placed in remote areas.
